Animals are very important to our planet. There are different types of animals: pets, farm animals, wild animals and sea animals. Usually, our pets and farm animals live safely in our homes and farms; however, some animals are losing their habitats (homes), their food and they may disappear.

When animals lose their habitats, they can disappear or become extinct, like the dinosaurs. Others are in danger of disappearing – endangered species – like the Pandas and the Koalas.
